Advanced Open Water: anytime by arrangement 5 fun dives and no exams! Build up your confidence in the water, fine tune your old skills and learn plenty of new ones in the PADI Advanced Open Water Diver Course. Times are flexible and we're always keen for a dive so get in touch to become an Advanced Open Water Diver. Remember we do offer one-to-one training.

PADI Rescue Diver: 31st June - 1st Aug. The course that everyone rates as the best PADI course out there. Learn self and buddy rescue skills. Become the diver that every one wants to dive with. The course requires that you have a current first aid certificate so if you don't already have one, we can sort that out too through an Emergency First Responder course (3 hours; \$170)
